WELCOME from the CEO

have always found it very easy to see life from a child's perspective. I don't know why but I have always had that point of view. To me there is no sweeter sound in life than hearing a child laugh. Makes my heart smile.

I chose this path to work for Boys & Girls Clubs nearly 30 years ago and it has been so incredibly rewarding. For my entire career I have worked at one Club or another where we, and I say we, not I, had tremendous impact. I look back at my time in Albany, NY where my career began and I remember working at the Clubs in the housing projects. I was the only white face in the whole community other than the police that came daily. It was in that community environment that I realized how important a Boys & Girls Club really was. It truly was an oasis in a desert of despair.

In Lodi New Jersey I learned the power of collaboration.

On day one we had four members. **Four!** We had a bad reputation and nobody sent their kids to the club. So we went to the schools and did recess programming. Every single day I volunteered at one of the 5 elementary schools to conduct recess programming. Did it work? By end of year one we had over 450 members.



In Everett Washington our Club was completely surrounded by low-income housing. It was here that I learned the importance of getting out of your building and getting those kids in your Clubs that need you the most. Go get em! We had children that wanted to attend but could not afford the \$40.00 membership fee. Thanks to a great collaboration with the Housing Authority Management we were able to scholarship all 400 plus kids that lived in that housing complex.

In Skagit County we put a Club in a shopping mall. That's right a mall. It was packed with kids and now that organization is thriving.

In Anaheim I learned the power of getting the big businesses behind you. This culminated when the Disneyland Resort made their single largest gift to a non-profit on the steps of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Anaheim.

t has been a little over 3 ½ years since I came to work for the

United Boys & Girls Clubs of Santa Barbara County. These past 18 months have been the most challenging of my career. That leads me to the lesson I learned about Santa Barbara County. No matter how many obstacles are thrown your way if you continue to do the right thing people will go out of their way to help you. With all the curveballs thrown our way these past 18 months (Flooding at Carptineria Club, Camp Whittier Fire and the Thomas Fire/ Montecito mudslides). We didn't shut down, we kept our doors open because our parents needed us. We opened our Carptineria Club to the students of Crane Country Day School because they needed us. We sent our club vans to help with the Bucket Brigade because our community needed us. We were able to do all of this because of each of you. You supported us through the tough times and allowed us to continue to serve those that need us the most. It is because of all of you that is still stay, "Coming to the United Boys & Girls Clubs of Santa Barbara County was the best decision of my career."


